

# McHenry County College AAS in Nursing to Saint Anthony College of Nursing RN to BSN Hybrid Program (2022-2023 Catalog)

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Transfer guides are produced as a service to MCC students. Saint Anthony College of Nursing provides the RN with an opportunity to take accelerated, hybrid courses in a mix of online and classroom format to pursue a baccalaureate degree in as little as 21 months. The BS in Nursing degree program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) and Higher Learning Commission (HLC).

## Application and Admission Information

- Complete application form online with non-refundable fee of \$75 and submit a copy of the applicant's current Illinois Registered Nurse License.
- Official transcripts of all courses taken at postsecondary institutions must be sent directly from each college or university attended to the admissions office at Saint Anthony College of Nursing.
- Applicants are reviewed on a rolling basis.
- Applicants must have successful completion of an approved RN program.
- Applicants are encouraged to consult with a Saint Anthony College of Nursing Admission Representative regarding plans to fulfill the prerequisites before registering for courses. Considering the cost and time involved in the mechanism of completing the prerequisites, this is to benefit the applicant in the event the applicant's plan does not meet the criteria. **Prerequisite courses may be taken concurrently** with the RN-BSN completion program, but must be complete by the time the student is ready to graduate from Saint Anthony.
- After acceptance, an updated official transcript is required for any courses taken prior to enrollment in the College of Nursing.
- After acceptance and before final acceptance, Saint Anthony will:
  - Conduct a criminal history records check and must render acceptable results;
  - Saint Anthony College of Nursing will conduct a drug test in accordance with the College's drug testing policy;
  - Final, official transcripts are due no later than the first day of classes.

#### <u>Saint Anthony Tuition</u> - \$544/per credit hour; does not include fees and books.
