IWU's convenient and flexible online version of its BSCJ was specifically designed to meet the busy lifestyles and unpredictable demands of working adults. This online program is designed without classroom sessions or the need to attend a campus. IWU is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and is a member of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Admission

- **Application and admission:** www.indwes.edu/Adult-Graduate/BS-Criminal-Justice/Apply-Now/
- **Application deadline:** IWU starts new cohorts year round, every 2-3 months. Students are recommended to apply 30 days before they want to start taking classes.
- **Minimum cumulative GPA** – none

Additional Information

- **Maximum hours accepted from a community college** – Up to 82 credits may be transferred from a community college and/or any regionally accredited college or university toward required credits for graduation.
- **GPA calculation for admission and course repeat policy** –The highest grade of a repeated course is calculated into the admission GPA if both courses were taken at the same school. Grades are averaged if the courses were taken at different schools.
- **Grade requirement** – A grade of C or better is required for a course's credits to transfer.
- **Tuition and fees** - Tuition rate is \$340 per credit hour (2012-2013 academic year). Fees for entire program add up to \$315. Tuition and fees are frozen and will not increase during the student's continual enrollment.
- **Program Structure** –
 - Students can access their courses no matter what time of day or night it may be.
 - Degree program requires 124 credits to graduate with BSCJ.
 - Accelerated program, 21 months to complete BSCJ.
 - Cohort model, class size usually 12-18 students.
 - Courses taken sequentially, one at a time, with completion of each course in about 5 weeks.
 - Register for all courses in program at one time with no obligation to pay for more courses than you take.
 - New cohorts start every 2-3 month.

- Students may to skip one or more courses and pick them up later if an emergency arises.
- Textbooks and course materials delivered directly to student.
- Technical support – live assistance every day of the week.
- **IIWU GPA Requirement** - Completion of IWU coursework with a GPA of at least 2.25.
