Admission

- **Application deadline:** Roosevelt uses a rolling admission, so there is no set application deadline. Students are recommended to apply by June 1 for fall semester and by September 1 for spring semester.
- **Minimum cumulative GPA – 2.00**

Additional Information

- **Maximum hours accepted from a community college** – Up to 66 credits may be transferred from a community college toward required credits for graduation.
- **GPA calculation for admission and course repeat policy** –The highest grade of a repeated course is calculated into the admission GPA if both courses were taken at the same school. Grades are averaged if the courses were taken at different schools.
- **Grade requirement** – A grade of C or better is required in ENG 151, ENG 152, math, and in all major-related coursework. The D grade is accepted for other general education course requirements and most electives (may be exceptions).
- **Tuition and fees** - Tuition and fees for this program is \$715.00 per credit hour (2013/14 academic year, for part-time enrollment). For full-time (12-18 hours per term), tuition is \$26,500 for both fall and spring terms combined plus fees.
- **Program Structure** - Students can access their courses no matter what time of day or night it may be. Online courses are generally 12 weeks in length.
