#### **Admission Criteria**

- Apply for admission to Aurora University and submit official transcripts of all prior academic work
- Submit evidence of RN licensure
- Recent graduate of an accredited nursing program or an RN with clinical experience within past five years (If not, complete a certified RN refresher course)
- 2.5 (on a 4.0 grading scale) cumulative GPA

**GPA calculation for admission** - based on all coursework transferring into Aurora from all institutions attended; for repeat courses, highest grade is calculated

**Class format** - year-round in eight-week modules, evening hours

**Grade requirements** - D grades not accepted in transfer

**Application deadlines** - rolling admission
