MCC and Capella have entered into a Program Articulation Agreement between the AAS in Accounting and the BS in Business Administration.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

- A McHenry County College graduate receiving an AAS in Accounting will be considered for admission if the following are met:
 - Completion of Capella University undergraduate admissions application and admission to the University
 - Meet admission criteria documented in current Capella University catalog (www.capella.edu/mchenry)
 - Completion of a minimum of 60 transferable credit hours to Capella University
 - Minimum cumulative 2.00 GPA as calculated by MCC
- Tuition and fee rates, admission criteria and academic requirements are subject to the Capella University catalog at the time of admission to Capella University
- Students must complete a minimum of 50 percent of their core and specialization courses at Capella University.
- MCC faculty, staff and graduates receive a 10% tuition reduction on all Capella University courses, excluding fees. Students eligible for this discount must identify themselves in order to get the discount. The tuition discount is not retroactive.
- Capella University extends benefits and expert resources to US Armed Forces students, including:
 - Tuition discounts up to 15%
 - Credit for military training
 - Post 9/11 GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon program
 - Dedicated military support services team
 - Flexible military leave policy
- Credit through prior learning assessment – Capella University allows student to document experiential learning for credit. If mastery of course-related competencies is successfully demonstrated, students are granted credit for the Capella course(s). The Prior Learning Assessment fee is substantially less than tuition for the equivalent courses.
- Students will have a minimum of 43 semester hours (64.5 quarter hours) of course work to complete through Capella, beyond course recommendations on this transfer guide (AAS plus additional course work to satisfy Capella general education requirements).
