MCC and Capella have entered into a Program Articulation Agreement between the associate degree (AA and AS) and the following bachelor degree programs:

- BS in Business (specializations in Accounting, Business Administration, Finance, Health Care Management, Human Resources Management, Management & Leadership, Marketing, Project Management, and Retail Management)
- BPA in General Public Administration
- BS in Information Technology (specializations in Health Informatics, Information Assurance & Security, Network Technology, Project Management, and Software Architecture)
- BS in Psychology
- BS in Public Safety (specializations in Criminal Justice, Emergency Management, and Homeland Security)

PROGRAM INFORMATION

- A McHenry County College graduate receiving an AA or an AS degree will be considered for admission into one of the programs listed above if the following are met:
 - Completion of Capella University undergraduate admissions application and admission to the University
 - Meet admission criteria documented in current Capella University catalog (www.capella.edu/mchenry)
 - Completion of a minimum of 60 transferable credit hours to Capella University
 - Minimum cumulative 2.00 GPA as calculated by MCC
- Tuition and fee rates, admission criteria and academic requirements are subject to the Capella University catalog at the time of admission to Capella University
- Completion of MCC's AA or AS degree satisfies Capella University's general education requirements.
- Students will have a minimum of 90 quarter hours (60 semester hours) of course work to complete through Capella University, upon completing the AA or the AS degree.
- Students must complete a minimum of 50 percent of their core and specialization courses at Capella University.
- MCC faculty, staff and graduates receive a 10% tuition reduction on all Capella University courses, excluding fees. Students eligible for this discount must identify themselves in order to get the discount. The tuition discount is not retroactive.
- Capella University extends benefits and expert resources to US Armed Forces students, including:
 - Tuition discounts up to 15%
 - Credit for military training
 - Post 9/11 GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon program
 - Dedicated military support services team
 - Flexible military leave policy
- Credit through prior learning assessment – Capella University allows student to document experiential learning for credit. If mastery of course-related competencies is successfully demonstrated, students are granted credit for the Capella course(s). The Prior Learning Assessment fee is substantially less than tuition for the equivalent courses.

- Other specializations: 64 semester hours (96 quarter hours) will be required beyond MCC's AA or AS degree
