Transfer guides are produced as a service to MCC students. Every effort is made to maintain up-to-date and accurate information; however, this information is subject to change. Such changes take precedence over the information on this guide. Students should work with an MCC advisor and the four-year transfer school. Responsibility for complying with all applicable requirements ultimately rests with the student.

The School of Business offers the BS in Business degree with majors in the following areas: Accounting; Business Administration (an off-campus program at Parkland College); Finance; Management; Management Information Systems; and Marketing. Academic programs are accredited by The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB). Students are admitted into the program on a competitive and selective basis. The requirements listed below represent the minimum standards and do not guarantee admittance.

Transfer Options

Transfer students are strongly advised to complete an AS or an AA degree that fulfills general education requirements and lower level College of Business tool courses before transferring to EIU.

- **AA or AS Degree** - Transfer students who receive an AA or an AS degree from an Illinois public community college and have a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher are guaranteed the following:
 - Minimum of 60 semester hours in transfer credit
 - Junior status
 - All lower division EIU General Education requirements automatically waived
 - The Cultural Diversity automatically waived.
- **Illinois Articulation Initiative** - Transfer students who complete the IAI General Education Core Curriculum (IAI GECC) from any participating college or university in Illinois are guaranteed the following:
 - All lower division EIU General Education requirements automatically waived
 - The Cultural Diversity automatically waived.
- **For students who transfer prior to completing an AA or an AS degree or the IAI core:**
 - EIU credit can be transferred back to MCC for completion of associate's degree.
 - IAI core can be completed at EIU.

Admission to the School of Business

Freshmen and lower-division students wishing to pursue a BS in Business are classified as pre-business and cannot begin upper-division business courses until admitted to upper division standing in the School of Business.

Transfer students who meet below criteria should indicate on the application for admission to the University that they intend to major in a School of Business program. No special application to the School of Business is required.

- At least 2.50 cumulative GPA (2.75 for students applying to accounting program), in good academic standing, and all transcripts on file at time of application
- Grades from all colleges/universities attended calculated into the GPA for entrance into School of Business (repeated grades used for GPA calculation)
- At least 60 semester hours completed by the end of the semester of application
- Completion of the following four tool courses with a grade of "C" or better in each (MCC courses in parentheses): Courses may be in process.
 - MAT2120G Finite Mathematics (MAT170)
 - BUS1950 Computer Concepts & Applications for Business (CIS110 & AOM131)
 - BUS2102 Managerial Accounting (ACC152)
 - BUS2810 Business Statistics I (MAT220)

Additional Information

- Business majors are required to complete at least 50% of the semester hours required for graduation in non-business courses.
- To qualify for the BS in Business degree from EIU, students must take at least 50% of their business credit hours at EIU.
- **Foreign Language Graduation Requirement:** Completion of the 2nd semester of a college foreign language or 2 full years of a single high school foreign language with a grade of "C" or better
- **Cultural Diversity:** Students are required to complete a course with a focus on cultural diversity. Students who have completed MCC's AA or AS degree (AS program listed on backside of this sheet) or the IAI GECC have completed this requirement.
- **Business Administration:** This major is only offered at EIU's off-campus extension on Parkland College's campus.
- **Maximum hours from a community college** - There is no maximum number of hours accepted; however, the following graduation requirements must be completed:
 - 120 semester hours with all general education and major requirements completed;
 - 40 semester hours of upper division (junior/senior level) courses;
 - 42 semester hours taken in Eastern (may include off-campus courses taught by EIU faculty); and
 - 56 semester hours at a baccalaureate (4-year) institution.

Education Plan

Completion of this program will satisfy the requirements for MCC's AS degree, the School of Business tool courses, and EIU'S general education core. The **bolded** courses satisfy the School of Business tool requirements. **Please refer to MCC's AS degree planning sheet or catalog for approved IAI and Intercultural Studies courses.**
