Responsibility for complying with all applicable requirements ultimately rests with the student.

The following programs leading to the Bachelor of Science degree are offered in the College of Business: accountancy, finance, business administration, management, marketing, operations and information management. The programs are accredited by AACSB International – The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business.

Admission Notes

- Submit application and supporting documents to the Office of Admissions. Refer to the NIU catalog for application information.
- Application deadline: Fall (July 15), Spring (December 1), Summer (May 1)
- Indicating primary area of academic interest on the application does constitute a declaration of a major.
- The student must formally request a transcript review for entrance into 300 and 400 level business courses. This occurs at NIU's College of Business orientation.

Requirements for Majors in the College of Business

Completion of all general education and lower division business core courses is encouraged, before transferring to NIU.

- The following options satisfy NIU's general education requirements for transfer students:
 - Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum (IAI GECC)
 - An MCC AA or AS degree
- Prerequisites for enrolling in NIU courses UBUS 310 and UBUS 311:
 - Junior standing
 - Completion of all 100 and 200 level College of Business core requirements with grade of C or better:

 - **OMIS259** will be required of all students enrolling in UBUS310 for Fall 2012 and after. Students enrolling in UBUS310 prior to Fall 2012 can still take the courses noted on MCC transfer guide for 2009/2010 catalog year.
 - Cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 (Accountancy requires a 3.2 GPA. and the grade of B or better in both ACC151 and ACC152 or obtain passing score on Accountancy Qualifying Examinations - AQE}
- No business course will be allowed on the pass/fail basis.

Additional Information

- Transfer coursework with grade of D is not accepted. Following are exceptions: (Please note: Regardless of exceptions, coursework will need to be repeated if required for major.) Students who are granted an AA or an AS degree from MCC and are accepted to NIU will be admitted with junior standing and with general education requirements considered complete.
- NIU will consider general education requirements complete for students who complete the IAI GECC package at MCC. (Credits from D grade coursework will not transfer.)
- GPA Calculation – Repeated courses for which a grade of C or better was earned in the first attempt will not be calculated into the admission GPA or be accepted for transfer credit. Repeated courses for which a grade of D or F was earned in the first attempt will be calculated into the admission GPA. The NIU College of Business will use D and F grades from transferable courses when calculating the 2.75 GPA required to enter UBUS 310.
- It is strongly recommended that ACC151 and 152 be taken during the sophomore rather than the freshman year.

The following is a suggested program for students who plan to complete the AS degree at McHenry County College and then transfer to an NIU College of Business program. Completion of this coursework will satisfy the following:

- Requirements for MCC’s AS degree
- NIU’s general education requirements
- NIU’s 100 and 200 level business core requirements (**bolded**)

Please refer to MCC’s AS degree planning sheet or catalog for approved IAI and Intercultural Studies courses. **It is always recommended that you work with an advisor when planning your transfer program.**
