The College of Business and Economics is accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) International. Major programs include Accounting, Economics, Finance and Business law, information Technology and Business Education, Management, Management Computer Systems, and Marketing.

Admission to the College of Business and Economics

- UW Whitewater application is required for admission to the University, along with application fee and high school and all college transcripts.
- Admission to the College of Business and Economics requires a separate application, completion of 54 transferable credits (including pre-business core listed below), completion of a computer applications course or passing the computer applications skills test, and a 2.80 GPA.
- Pre-business students are eligible to enroll in lower-division business courses after completing 24 credits with at least a 2.5 GPA.
- Application to University deadline: Fall, May 1; Spring, November 15
- Minimum cumulative GPA
 - ✓ University – 2.0
 - Pre-business students with 0 to 24 credits: 2.00
 - Pre-business students with 24 to 71 credits: 2.50
 - Pre-business students with 72 or more credits: 2.80
 - ✓ College of Business and Economics – 2.80
- Following are course requirements for entrance into the College of Business and Economics:

Additional Information

- ✓ University-wide proficiency and general education requirements are satisfied with completion of an AA or an AS degree from MCC (exception – GENED390, World of Ideas). Students should remind UW-Whitewater advisors that they have earned the associate degree to ensure they are not needlessly advised into general education courses. Students who transfer before earning an AA or an AS degree will need to complete specific UW-Whitewater general education courses.
- ✓ International Requirement – This is a College of Business and Economics graduation requirement and can be satisfied by taking one of the following courses: ANT151, 170; ART155; ENG253, 254, 276; GEG202, 203, 204; HIS165; IBS115; MUS153; PHI160, 261; PLT251, 255, 281. This requirement can be completed upon transfer to Whitewater.
- ✓ Diversity Requirement – This is a UW Whitewater graduation requirement and can be satisfied by taking SOC260. SOC260.
- ✓ Course Repeat Policy - Courses with grades of C- or lower may be repeated one time. The higher grade counts toward admission GPA. All other repeat courses are calculated into GPA.
- ✓ D grades are transferable.

The following is a suggested program for students who plan to complete the A.S. degree at McHenry County College and then transfer to the University of Wisconsin - Whitewater as business major. Completion of this course work will satisfy the following:

- Requirements for MCC's AS degree
- UWW's general education requirements
