MCC and WIU have entered into a Program Articulation Agreement between the AAS in Criminal Justice degree and the BS in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration degree. The agreement allows a student to complete the BS degree in 60 hours beyond the AAS degree, providing the student completes all the suggested coursework, completes the AAS degree with the appropriate grade point average, and does not choose to double major/double minor or complete a semester abroad while at Western. These are good experiences and options that will most likely require additional hours beyond 60 semester hours.

Admission Notes

- The Law Enforcement and Justice Administration program is available at the Macomb or Quad Cities campus.
- Students are admitted to Western Illinois University through the Office of Admissions.
- Applications for admission to the University are accepted throughout the year. Recommended application deadline for Spring semester is December 1 and Fall semester is August 1. To apply online: www.admissions.wiu.edu/application
- Students who transfer to Western the next semester after earning an associate degree will lock into the previous year's rates for tuition, fees, room and board.
- To become an LEJA major:
 - At least 60 semester hours of WIU and/or transferable credit
 - Minimum of a 2.50 cumulative GPA for all collegiate coursework
 - Completion of the following courses:

- Students who do not meet these course requirements or GPA will not be allowed to enroll in upper division (300/400 level) LEJA courses until a 2.5 GPA has been attained at Western. Students who do not meet the course requirements but have attained 60 semester hours and a 2.5 GPA may enroll in upper division LEJA courses where the prerequisites have been met.

Additional Information –

Successful completion of MCC and WIU courses noted on this guide will satisfy required coursework for MCC's AAS degree in Criminal Justice and will be applied to Western's BS degree in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration. Students who complete the recommended MCC courses on this guide and meet the minimum GPA will have:

- junior standing upon transferring to Western.
- to complete the WIU General Education requirements. Students will have to complete an additional 10 semester hours of General Education course work at Western.
- to complete 60 semester hours at a four year institution of which 40 must be in upper division courses (30 semester hours must be completed at WIU).
- to complete a minimum of 30 semester hours in LEJA courses at Western (including internship) and 9 semester hours must be at the 300/400 level.

It is important to seek guidance from MCC's Criminal Justice department chair and academic advisors.
