- Began with 2 Certificate programs
Chef's Assistant I & Baking & Pastry Assistant I
- An Associate of Applied Science degree in Culinary Management was approved by the ICCB in June, 2011
- In the Spring of 2014 we expect to have approved the Associate of Applied Science degree in Baking and Pastry
