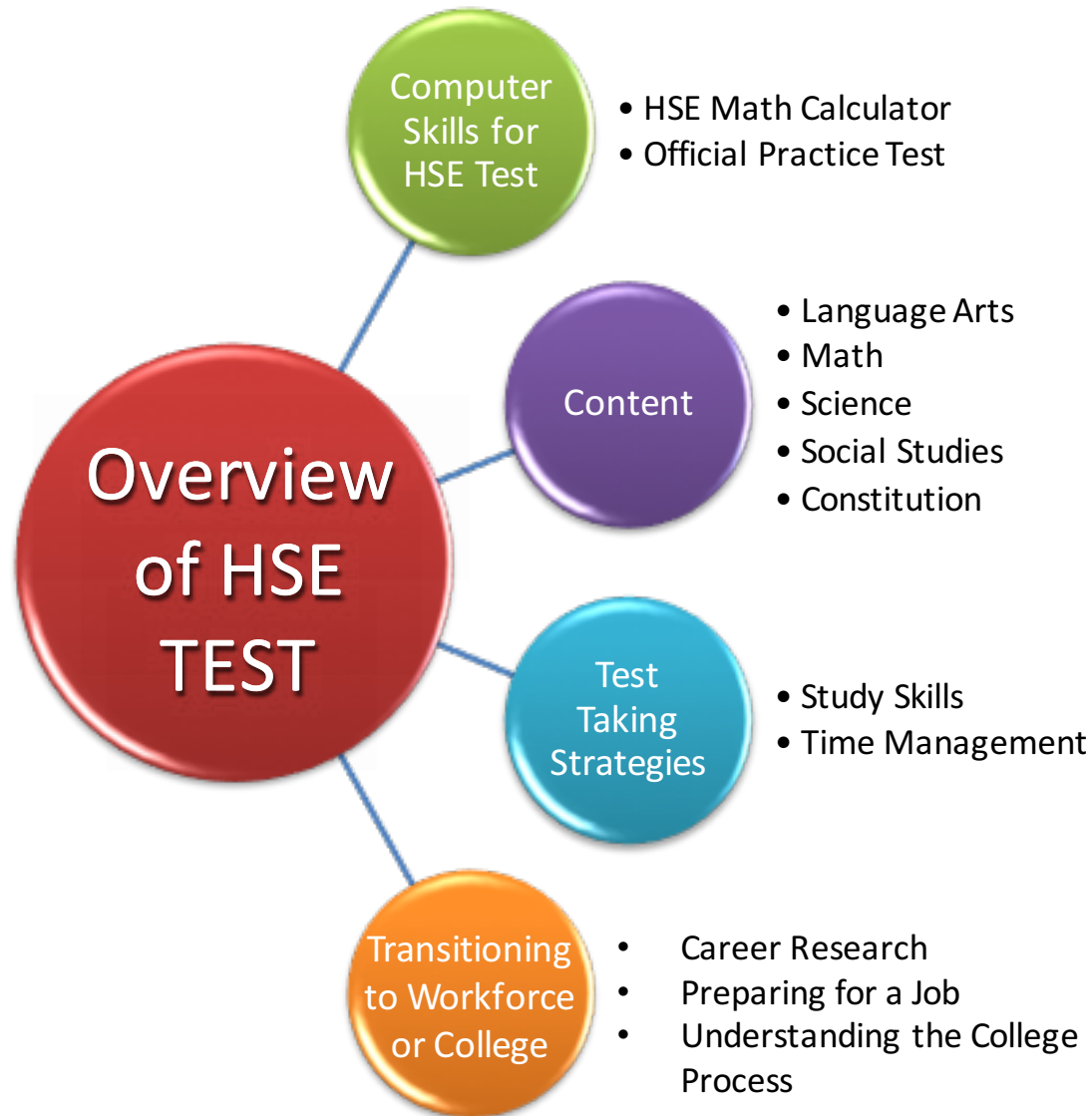

 - Pre-Test at the beginning of every school year
 - Post-Test after 40 or 60 hours of instruction
- Students may be tested multiple times in an academic year
