Course Requirements

- A grade of C or better is required for all general education and support courses: BIO255, BIO263, BIO264, ENG151, HCE110, HCE111, HFE250, PHI251, PSY151, PSY250, and SPE151 (or equivalent courses). BIO255, BIO263 and BIO264 (or BIO260) of acceptance into the nursing program.
- CHM164 or an equivalent must be completed if high school chemistry was not taken. Grade of C or better required in CHM164 and B or better in high school chemistry.
- The cumulative GPA for general education and support courses must equal 2.5 or better.
- MAT079 or MAT099 or a college algebra course with a C or better or placement into MAT161 on the Math Placement Exam is required.

Other Requirements

- You must complete the preadmission test (TEAS®). See annual test dates and procedures.
- Preference will be given to residents of Community College District #528. Check to see if you live in District 528.
