<p>Admission Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proof of high school graduation or GED certification • Prior completion of at least 60 transferable credit hours from a regionally accredited college or university • A minimum of two years of related full-time work experience (or four years part-time) beyond high school (except RN-BSN) • RN-BSN – currently employed as a licensed RN or one year of nursing experience • GPA requirements may vary among majors 	
<p>Additional Information</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 79-94 credits transfer from a community college, depending on IWU major • No expiration on past credits earned • Generally, all major core courses are completed through IWU (30-45 credits) • Cohort model – 12-18 students <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Accelerated programs (19-25 months) ○ Courses taken sequentially, one at a time – generally 5-6 week sessions ○ Students may skip one or more courses and pick them up later ○ Textbooks and course materials delivered directly to student; included in total program cost • BS in General Studies is independent study (not cohort model), which allows students to choose pace of coursework to complete degree, i.e., 10 months to 5 years • Technical support – live assistance every day of the week • Will work with Associate in Applied Science degrees • Credit for prior learning through assessment process, CLEP, DANTES testing for credits
