STUDENT GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS

2018 SKYWAY JURIED ART COMPETITION

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Skyway Juried Art Competition is to provide an opportunity for emerging student artists to display their work.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Any student currently enrolled in one of the Skyway Conference colleges is eligible to enter.
- Students who have had work awarded a prize in last year's Skyway show will not be eligible. College Art Coordinators are responsible for keeping records and verifying eligibility. Work submitted by a college that is later recognized to be ineligible will be disqualified.
- Students will submit work to their art department, who will be responsible for selecting the college's submission to the competition. See details below.
- Works must have been completed for class credit during the following semesters: Spring 2017, Summer 2017, Fall 2017, and Spring 2018.
- Work must be properly cited. If the class assignment from which the student submission originates is to copy an artist's work or create a piece influenced or based on the work of another artist, appropriate citation must be provided on the inventory sheet. If the artwork is selected for the exhibition, the host college will include this information on signage identifying the artwork.

SALES:

Works need not be for sale; however, sales are invited. All work for sale will be at the artist's valuation. Indicate for sale/not for sale on the entry form. Students will be given prospective buyer's contact information. No student contact information will be released. Oakton Community College will not be directly involved in the sale of any work exhibited in the Skyway Juried Art Competition except to notify student of contact information of prospective buyer.

STUDENT ENTRY FORMS:

Fill out form **completely** and attach securely as is appropriate to each submission. (Please attach to the back of 2-D or bottom of 3-D work.)

LIABILITY:

Every effort will be made to ensure proper care and handling of the artwork while present on the Oakton campus. Only works accepted for exhibition will be insured while on display at the Koehnline Museum of Art. Instructors should assist students in determining reasonable values for their work. Works will be insured for price listed, but if NFS and no insurance value is listed, a limit of \$50 will be covered. Oakton Community College and the Skyway Juried Art Competition will not assume responsibility for loss or damage of works while in transit. These forms are required.

AWARDS:

All students who have work accepted for the exhibition will receive a Certificate of Recognition. The jurors will select the following awards: Best of Show, four Awards of Excellence and four Awards of Merit. The awards are medallions and will be presented during the Skyway Juried Art Competition reception on March 25, 2018, 1 - 3 p.m.

SUBMISSIONS:

Each college will select up to 25 pieces in some or all of the following categories to represent the college in the competition: ceramics, drawing, design, electronic imagery, photography, printmaking, sculpture, and other media.

For information about the selection process at your college, contact your art instructor.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR EXHIBITION:

All 2-D work must be properly framed and wired to hang. No saw tooth hangers. Stretched canvases need not be framed, if sides are presentable and must be wired. All artwork must be able to fit through a standard 36" doorway and cannot exceed a limit of 60" high x 48" wide'. Weight limit is 200 lbs.
