

Fall 2017 10th Day Enrollment Report

Office of Institutional Research

September 2017

Summary

- This fall, headcount and credit hour enrollment increased compared to Fall 2016.
 - Total headcount is 6,844, a 7.4% increase from 2016.
 - Total credit hours are 56,197.0, 4.5% higher than Fall (see Table 1).
- In Fall 2017 MAT-095 was offered as dual credit instead of articulated credit for the first time. This resulted in 495 high school students that were included in the MCC credit count.
- Students' age distribution shows a shift to more students age 19 or younger over the last five years with 59% of the credit student body represented by this category. A 19.3% increase from 2016 (see Table 1).
- Enrollment in the 35-55 age group category continues to decline; specifically, there was a -4.6% decrease as compared to Fall 2016 (see Table 1). This is a common statewide trend as the economy recovers from a recession and adults return back to work.
- Enrollment in courses carrying a dual credit course type have increased 78% (see Table 1). (Please note this is not a complete capture of High School Plus program enrollment and is greatly impacted by the MAT-095 change to dual credit).
- Online course enrollment decreased -1.4% compared to Fall 2016 (see Table 1).
- Math Science and Health Professions enrollment has increased 11.3% in credit hours (largely from the MAT-095 dual credit change) and Humanities and Social Sciences has increased 4.7% Education Career and Technical Education is down -2.5% compared to 2016 (see Table 1).
- In Fall 2017 program enrollments for the Associate in Arts increased 61.5% (675 in Fall 2016 to 1090 in Fall 2017) while enrollments for the Associate in Science decreased from 1,238 in Fall 2016 to 955 in Fall 2017 (See Table 3). This change was precipitated by changes in the requirements for the Associate in Arts (removing a foreign language) and the Associate in Science (adding additional math and science) that took effect Fall 2016.

Figure 2: Fall 10th Day Credit Hour Enrollment by Division

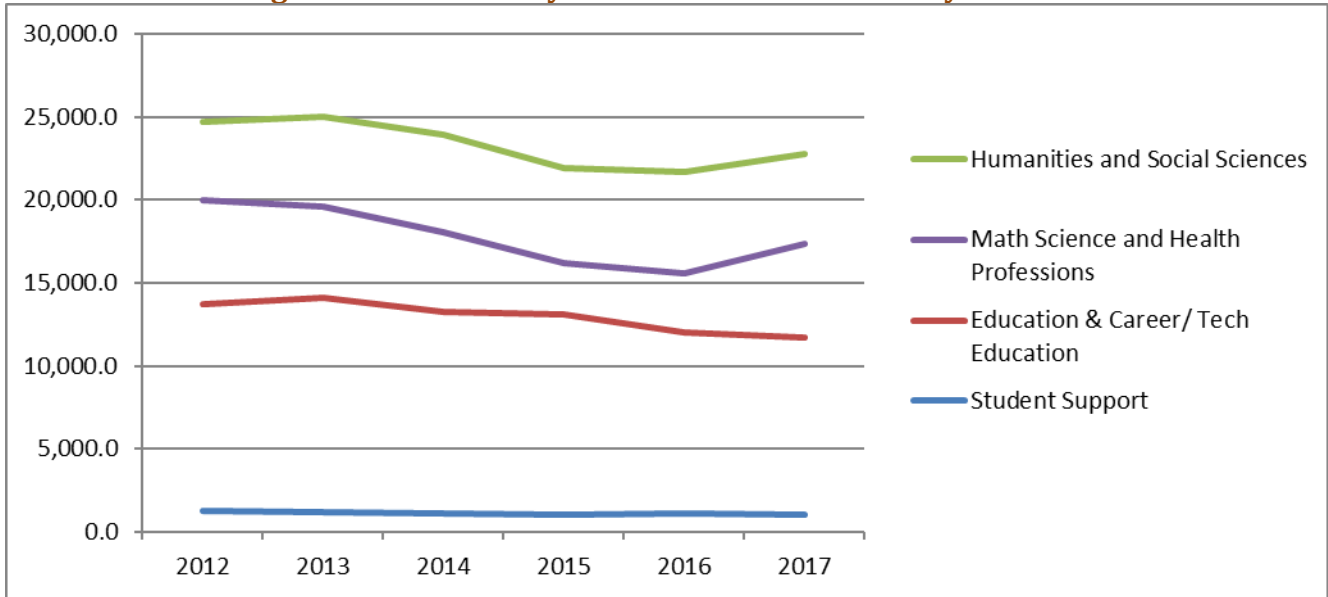


Figure 3: 5-Year Change in 10th Day Fall Credit Hours by Division and Prefix

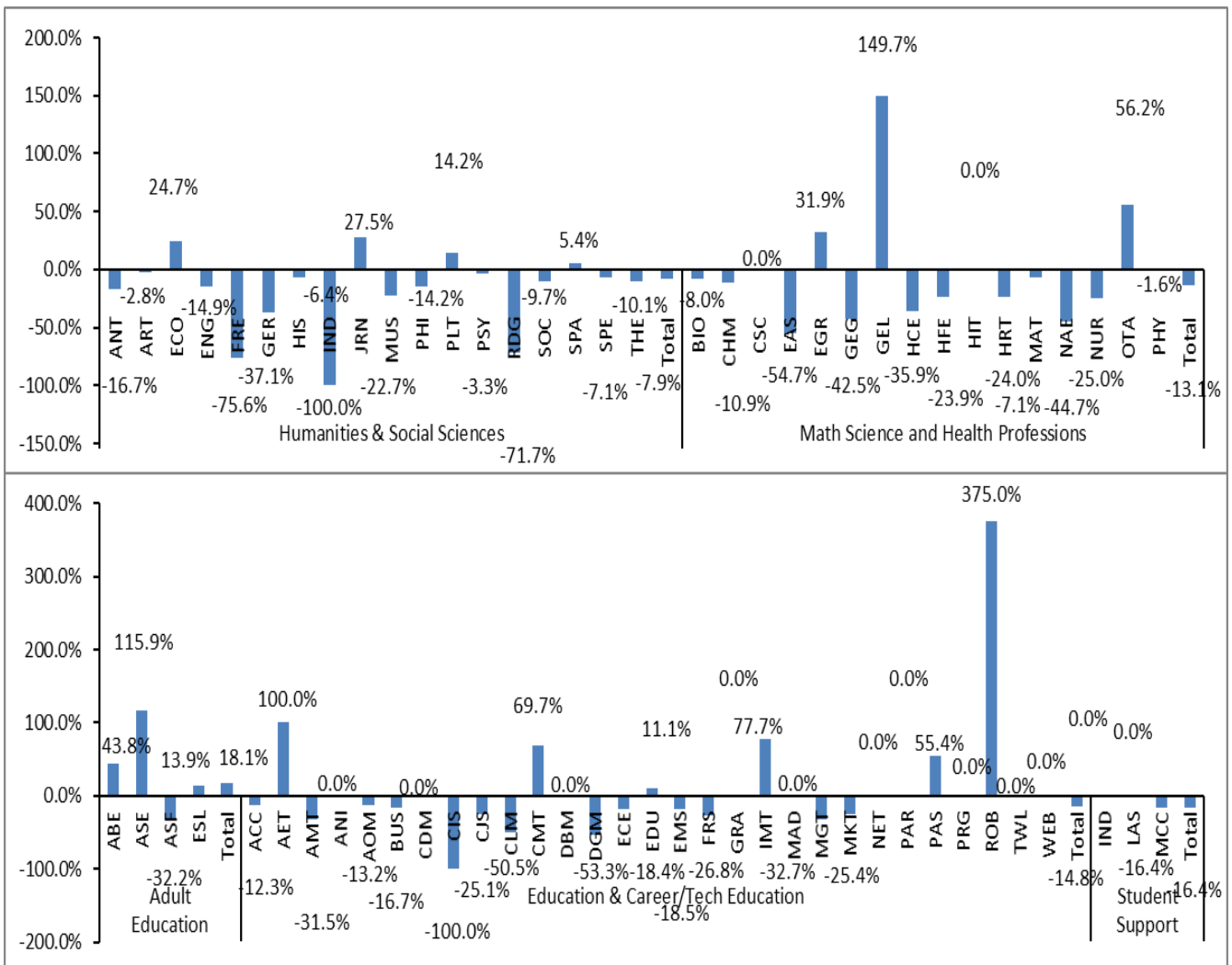
