MINUTES SPECIAL BOARD MEETING OF MCHENRY COUNTY COLLEGE

FOGLIA CENTER FOR ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION SCOPE AND DESIGN SELECTION – CDB PROJECT 810-066-019, BOARD REPORT #21-92

Representatives of Ross Barney Architects were on hand to present two options for the Board of Trustees' consideration for the new Foglia Center for Advanced Technology and Innovation. Ms. Carol Ross Barney, Chief Architect, along with Ryan Giblin, Ryan Gann and Jonathan Graves recapped the process, design concepts, cost, and sustainability of both design options. Considering that one option offers more instructional space, coupled with the cost coming in \$295,349 under the proposed budget cost of \$19,705.292, Dr. Gabbard recommended that the Board of Trustees approve Option #1, referred to as the Pavilion. Its design elements would mesh with existing buildings on the MCC campus, and offers good value per square footage. With the projected cost savings of Option #1, the hope is this may allow the College an option to consider a connection between this new center and an existing building for contained interior access, as MCC has done with Buildings A through F.

When Chair Siddons asked for a motion, Ms. Walsh moved, with a second by Mr. Allen, to approve Option #1 as the design for the new Foglia Center for Advanced Technology and Innovation CDB Project 810-066-019. On a roll call vote, all voted in favor. Motion carried.
