It is that time of year to begin preparation for the 2022-2023 McHenry Western Lake County EMS(MWLC) in conjunction with McHenry County College (MCC) Paramedic Program. This course requires a significant amount of dedication, commitment, and time. Please consider this when evaluating and exploring your professional career options. Candidates are required to have at least 6 months of patient contact experience. Candidates must also be affiliated with an EMS agency within the MWLC EMS.

Paramedic orientation will be held at **MCC on Saturday April 30 at 9am, in F 208**. This orientation will provide candidates with the details and requirements of the program, as well as tips for successful completion. *Attending orientation is mandatory, absent extenuating circumstances must be communicated to the lead instructor prior to 4/30.*

Candidates must successfully pass an entrance exam, followed by skills testing and an oral interview. The dates are as follows:

- **Written exam- Monday, May 16, 5pm at MCC, F 208**
- **Skills testing- Thursday, May 19, 12p-4pm at MCC, classroom E202**
- **Oral interviews- Tuesday, May 24 10a-4p and Wednesday, May 25 2p-6p at MCC in classroom E202**
