We highly encourage all of our students to complete the FAFSA. Completing the FAFSA will determine if you are eligible for free federal and/or state aid or a federal direct Stafford loan. The federal direct Stafford loan is a guaranteed student loan that will not require you to make payments on the principal while enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours). Generally, the federal direct Stafford loan offers more benefits than an alternative loan.

If you have completed the FAFSA but did not list MCC as a school, simply make a correction to your application and add MCC. Our federal school code is 007691.
