### **Additional Information – Baccalaureate Programs**

- Completion of MCC's AA or AS degree satisfies Capella University's general education requirements.
- MCC faculty, staff and graduates receive a 10% tuition reduction on all Capella University courses, excluding fees. Students eligible for this discount must identify themselves in order to get the discount. The tuition discount is not retroactive. (applies to undergraduate and graduate programs)
- Capella University extends benefits and expert resources to US Armed Forces students, including:
  - Tuition discounts up to 15%
  - Credit for military training
  - Post 9/11 GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon program
  - Dedicated military support services team
  - Flexible military leave policy
- Credit through prior learning assessment – Capella University allows student to document experiential learning for credit. If mastery of course-related competencies is successfully demonstrated, students are granted credit for the Capella course(s). The Prior Learning Assessment fee is substantially less than tuition for the equivalent courses.
